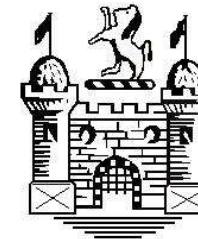

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

General Will all competitors report to Kevin Brown-Warr (or deputising Committee Member) at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start time of their game. Times & rinks may be subject to change by the committee in the interests of the competition and players. Semi-final winners may call Kevin Brown-Warr on 07828 923569 between 9pm and 10pm on Saturday evening for the time of their final on Sunday.

Dress Code Competitors are reminded of the dress rules, as found on pages 56-57 of the County Handbook.

1. For all rounds of all County Individual and Senior/Junior Cup Competitions up to and including Area Finals the following shall apply:-
All male players shall wear a white shirt, or predominately white if supplied by a bonafide bowls wear manufacturer, i.e. coloured piping, trim, collars and cuffs etc, not sleeves or shirt panels, grey trousers or grey tailored or sports type shorts as supplied by an approved bowls wear manufacturer, and approved smooth bowling shoes. Any tops such as sweatshirts, pullovers or sheen jackets shall be white, or predominately white if supplied by a bonafide bowls wear manufacturer, i.e. coloured piping, trim, collars and cuffs etc, not sleeves or shirt panels, or cream. Waterproofs shall be predominately white.

All female players must wear the SCWBA standard dress as stipulated in the current SCWBA handbook.

Club coloured shirts (see Rule 4 [below]) may be worn providing all players (male and female) are dressed alike. Where polo shirts are worn, any tops such as sweatshirts, sheen jackets or pullovers shall either be of an identical matching colour or white, or predominately white if supplied by a bonafide bowls wear manufacturer, i.e. coloured piping, trim, collars and cuffs etc, not sleeves or shirt panels, or cream, providing all players wear the same.

4. Club coloured shirts may be sports-type (polo) with turned down collar (not tee shirt) and long or short sleeves (not sleeveless) and may display one identifying club badge/logo and/or one sponsor's name/logo that must not exceed 100mm square each. Where polo shirts are worn, any tops such as sweatshirts, sheen jackets or pullovers shall either be of an identical matching colour or white, or predominately white if supplied by a bonafide bowls wear manufacturer, i.e. coloured piping, trim, collars and cuffs etc, not sleeves or shirt panels, or cream, providing all players wear the same. Club colours (or any changes) must be registered with the County Secretary, by written notification prior to their use. Clubs not registering a colour will default to white.

8. **Any players improperly dressed for any of the above will be disqualified and will not be allowed to participate. ...**
